Scope: The scope of this document is to highlight the process and pre-requisites for taking Siksha (instruction) and Diksha (initiation) in ISKCON Seattle. 1st Initiates who aspire to take second initiation must review this document which would assist in their Spiritual planning process towards this very Important step in their Sadhana. Please remember that the process of developing a service relationship with an ISKCON guru is a **natural** one that stands the test of time.

Introduction:

This Document will first highlight Excerpts from ISKCON Law and then provide the process, prerequisites and additional guidelines required for both 1st and 2nd initiation in ISKCON Seattle.

Excerpts from ISKCON Law on Discipleship in ISKCON

Excerpts from ISKCON Law on Discipleship in ISKCON

7.2.1. First (Harināma) Initiation

7.2.1.1. Qualifications for First Initiation

7.2.1.1.1. One year preparatory period

In order to receive first initiation one must have been engaged favourably in devotional service, strictly following the four regulative principles and chanting sixteen rounds a day, for at least one year without interruption.

7.2.1.1.2. First Six Month Period

During the first six months of following the four regulative principles and chanting sixteen rounds daily, a new devotee who is aspiring for initiation should not commit himself to a particular initiating *guru*. Rather, he should chant Srila Prabhupada's *pranāma-mantra* and worship him as Founder-Ācārya of ISKCON and as his śīksā guru.

7.2.1.1.3. Second Six Month Period

After successfully completing the first six-month preparatory period, and after passing the required examination, the candidate may choose his future *dikśā guru*. Receiving permission from that *guru*, and notifying the local temple president, the candidate should take shelter and begin to worship that *guru* as his own spiritual master and chant his *praṇāma-mantra*. Actual initiation may take place only after a minimum six-month period from the date shelter was taken and the local temple president notified.

7.2.1.1.4. Devotees Residing Within Temple Communities

In addition to satisfying the above requirements, devotees residing in temple communities must, during the one-year preparatory period, regularly attend the full morning program.

7.2.3.1.1.5. Devotees Residing Outside of Temple Communities

Devotees who do not live in a temple community and who cannot come daily to the temple programs may be initiated provided they have regular morning programs at home or attend regular morning programs at the *nāma-haṭṭa* centre.

7.2.1.1.6. Pass Examination

Before a devotee can be permitted to formally take shelter of a particular ISKCON spiritual master and be subsequently recommended for initiation, he or she must demonstrate a basic understanding of Srila Prabhupada's teachings by answering an oral or written test administered by the temple president or other recommending authority.

ISKCON Governing Board Committee Annual General Meeting 2014, Resolution 317

"That the ISKCON Disciple Course, as developed by the GBC Guru Services Committee, shall be a mandatory prerequisite for all devotees accepting first or second initiation by an ISKCON guru, effective Janmastami, 2015. After that date, no guru may initiate a disciple who has not first completed the Disciple Course. This is in addition to current requirements of new initiates."

Formal Process and workflow for taking 1st Initiation:

SECOND SIX MONTH PERIOD:

First Initiation Pre-Requisites (Second Six-month period)	Status
1. Chant your initiating Spiritual Master pranams (If applicable)	
2. Continue Chanting 16 rounds daily and strictly following the 4 regulative principles	
3. Increase Steady sadhana and develop a steady service relationship with your spiritual master	
4. Complete the reading of Srimad Bhagavatam Canto 1 (With purports) and Nectar of Devotion (Till Chapter 19 at minimum)	
5. Learn the Guru Ashtavakam (To be recited without help of a book as per ISKCON Law)	
 Send formal mail to Temple Presidents and Head Pujari to appear for 1st initiation interview (Ir person))-
7. At the end of a successful interview sign the 1 st Initiation oath	
8. Receive formal recommendation letter from Temple presidents.	
9. Request 1 st initiation from your Spiritual master by sending the letter of recommendation	
10. If initiation is not conducted in ISKCON Seattle receive letter of approval from ISKCON Seattle Temple Presidents and update the Temple presidents once 1 st initiation is formally completed.	

Formal Process/workflow for requesting Second Initiation:

- 1. 1st initiates after meeting the basic pre-requisites must send mail to Temple Presidents and Head Pujari expressing their Intent to take second initiation.
- Temple Presidents and Head Pujari will complete the 2nd Initiation Detailed Preliminary qualifications evaluation for the candidate and reply to requested e-mail documenting next steps.
- 3. During the evaluation if there are gaps in pre-requisites Temple Presidents and Head Pujari will provide guidance on next steps with timelines such that a re-evaluation can be done at later date (Revised date as per discretion of Temple Presidents)
- 4. If all Pre-requisites are met the 1st initiates will be requested to appear for a formal interview where the detailed preliminary qualifications will be reviewed and discussed.
- 5. Upon Successful completion of the Interview Temple Presidents and Head Pujari will send the Official Recommendation Letter for Second Initiation to the initiating Spiritual Master.

Second Initiation Candidate's Pre-requisite Checklist:

Second Initiation Pre-Requisites	Status
1. For at least Two years after first initiation, continues fulfilling all requirements for first	
initiation.	
2. Has performed Consistently direct, measurable/trackable services in the Deity Department	
assigned by the Head Pujari for a minimum of Two years.	
3. Has performed Consistently additional Temple Service/s (Non-Deity) as assigned by the Temple	
presidents for a minimum of Two years.	
4. Demonstrates the qualities of a Brahmana (Bg 18.42) and a tendency to continually improve in	
those qualities and is in good standing in the Temple community.	
5. Continually develops good relationships with devotees in the congregation and acts as a good	
role model for Inspiring other future Brahamanas.	
6. Practices the threefold austerity of the mode of goodness, as described in Bg 17.14-16	
7. Exemplifies religious principles to the public, representing ISKCON and Srila Prabhupada.	
8. Fits into and represents ISKCON's organizational structure; i.e., GBC to Regional Governing	
Bodies (and similar local councils), Temple Presidents.	
9. Has read the following Srila Prabhupada's books at a minimum: Bhagavad-gita As It Is, Srimad	
Bhagavatam, Nectar of Devotion, Nectar of Instruction and Isopanisad.	
10. Has formally attended a Bhakti Shastri course (Final Exam is optional) and can provide	
reference letter from Bhakti Shastri Tutor that he/she has just attended the course.	
11. Recommendations from 3 Brahmanas in the local congregation who are in very good standing	
with Local Temple and ISKCON Authorities.	
12. Recommendation Letter from Spiritual master for taking second initiation	
13. Has been actively assisting in some preaching or outreach activity for the past 6 months.	
14. Is currently visiting Temple at-least a minimum 5 times per week	
15. Is known to chant his/her 16 rounds daily and follow all the regulative principles sincerely.	
16. No major fall-down or non-adherence to any of the regulative principles in the past 2 years	
17. Does not offend Vaishnava's and does not engage in un-constructive criticism of devotees	
18. No Formal complaints registered to the Temple Authorities on the candidate	
19. If the above 18-point Checklist is successfully completed – In Person Interview/Discussion with	
Temple Presidents and Head Pujari.	
20. Temple Presidents send the Document with Temple recommendation to initiating spiritual	
master	
21. If initiation is not conducted in ISKCON Seattle receive letter of approval from ISKCON Seattle	
Temple Presidents and update the Temple presidents once 2nd initiation is formally	
completed.	

Initial Guidelines post 2nd Initiation:

- After Second Initiation Devotees are requested to wait for 6-7 months (minimum) before
 they can be engaged directly on Altar Service. During this period, newly Second initiated
 devotees use this as a settling period. Wait period can be longer as per discretion of
 Temple Presidents and Head Pujari.
- Service allocation is done based on Availability and wait-listed sequence, there will be a
 formal orientation meeting conducted by Temple President and Head Pujari where the
 details of the Service and progression will be discussed.
- While smaller absences and details are covered in the orientation meeting any break in Altar related services which exceed more than 5 months will result in a re-orientation and re-assignment of the services again subject to availability and wait-listed sequence.
- For any Break's exceeding greater than 1 month there should be a formal E-mail/Request to the Temple Presidents and Head Pujari indicating the reason for Break.
- Resuming services after breaks exceeding greater than 5 months or Switching of Services
 is still subject to Availability and wait-listed sequence and also a cooling period (minimum
 of 3 months) at the discretion of Temple Presidents and Head Pujari.

Guidelines to Re-Instating Your Candidature After a Falldown

- If you have stopped chanting or following the 4 regulative principles please formally update your Spiritual Master, Temple Presidents and Local Temple Authorities.
- Candidates for 1st initiation must chant 16 rounds daily and follow the 4 regulative
 principles for at least 12 months to become re-eligible for initiation. You must log at
 least 12 months standard sadhana practice (verified by Temple presidents) before you
 may be recommended for initiation.
- Candidates for 2nd initiation must chant 16 rounds daily and follow the 4 regulative principles for at least 24 months to become re-eligible for initiation. You must log at least 2 years standard sadhana practice (verified by Temple presidents and Head Pujari) before you may be recommended for initiation.

Bg 9.30-34

Even if one commits the most abominable action, if he is engaged in devotional service he is to be considered saintly because he is properly situated in his determination. He quickly becomes righteous and attains lasting peace...Therefore, having come to this temporary, miserable world, engage in loving service unto Me. Engage your mind always in thinking of Me, become My devotee, offer obeisances to Me and worship Me. Being completely absorbed in Me, surely you will come to Me.

PURPORT (to Text 31): This should not be misunderstood. In the Seventh Chapter the Lord says that one who is engaged in mischievous activities cannot become a devotee of the Lord. One who is not a devotee of the Lord has no good qualifications whatsoever. The question remains, then, 'How can a person engaged in abominable activities—either by accident or by intention—be a pure devotee?' This question may justly be raised. The miscreants, as stated in the Seventh Chapter, who never come to the devotional service of the Lord, have no good qualifications, as is stated in the Srimad-Bhagavatam. Generally, a devotee who is engaged in the nine kinds of devotional activities is engaged in the process of cleansing all material contamination from the heart. He puts the Supreme Personality of Godhead within his heart, and all sinful contaminations are naturally washed away...Therefore, the chanting of Hare Krishna, Hare Krishna, Krishna, Krishna, Hare Hare/ Hare Rama, Hare Rama, Rama Rama, Hare Hare should be continued without stoppage.
